
- The award is equivalent to studying at A level
- 5 days course split over 2 weeks, with assessed role plays on 4 of those days and also classroom sessions. Then 5 written questions totalling approx. 2500 words.

- be able to demonstrate the skills and behaviours needed to be an effective mediator
- know the mediation model and the key tasks of each stage
- be able to manage the mediation process effectively and confidently
- know how to evaluate their own performance and that of others
