Justice for Colombia

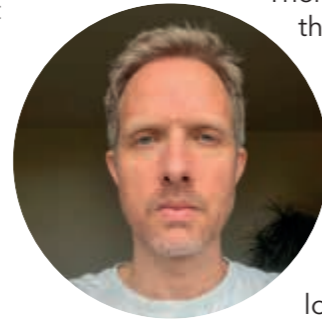
Colombia is the most dangerous place in the world to be a trade unionist. More than 3,300 unionists have been killed since 1971 - targeted for their activism in a country wracked by violent conflict and deep inequality.

Justice for Colombia (JFC) exists to link unions in the UK and Ireland with trade unionists, peasant organisations and human rights defenders in Colombia. It aims to help our movement offer practical solidarity where it's needed most.

JFC staff are regulars at Congress. "It's the one place that all the unions come together," says Nick MacWilliam (pictured above), JFC's trade unions and programmes officer. "We can speak to activists and leaders across the union movement, and we always find there's really high interest in the work we're doing."

With a peace agreement in place and the country's first ever union-backed government, hopes are rising. But the situation is fragile, change is slow, and the violence continues. "Transforming this situation on the ground is going to be a very long-term process," Nick says. "And our work is still really important to support the change taking place at community level, and for workers to organise safely for their rights."

This year, Nick will be joined at Congress by Fabio Arias Giraldo, president of Colombian union federation CUT. It's a great



chance to hear first-hand about the real situation in Colombia.

There are many ways that delegates can support JFC, such as affiliating their branches, taking a photo to help spread the word to their members, or supporting JFC's lobbying work with their local MPs. Visit the stand to find out how you can be involved, too. 🇨🇴

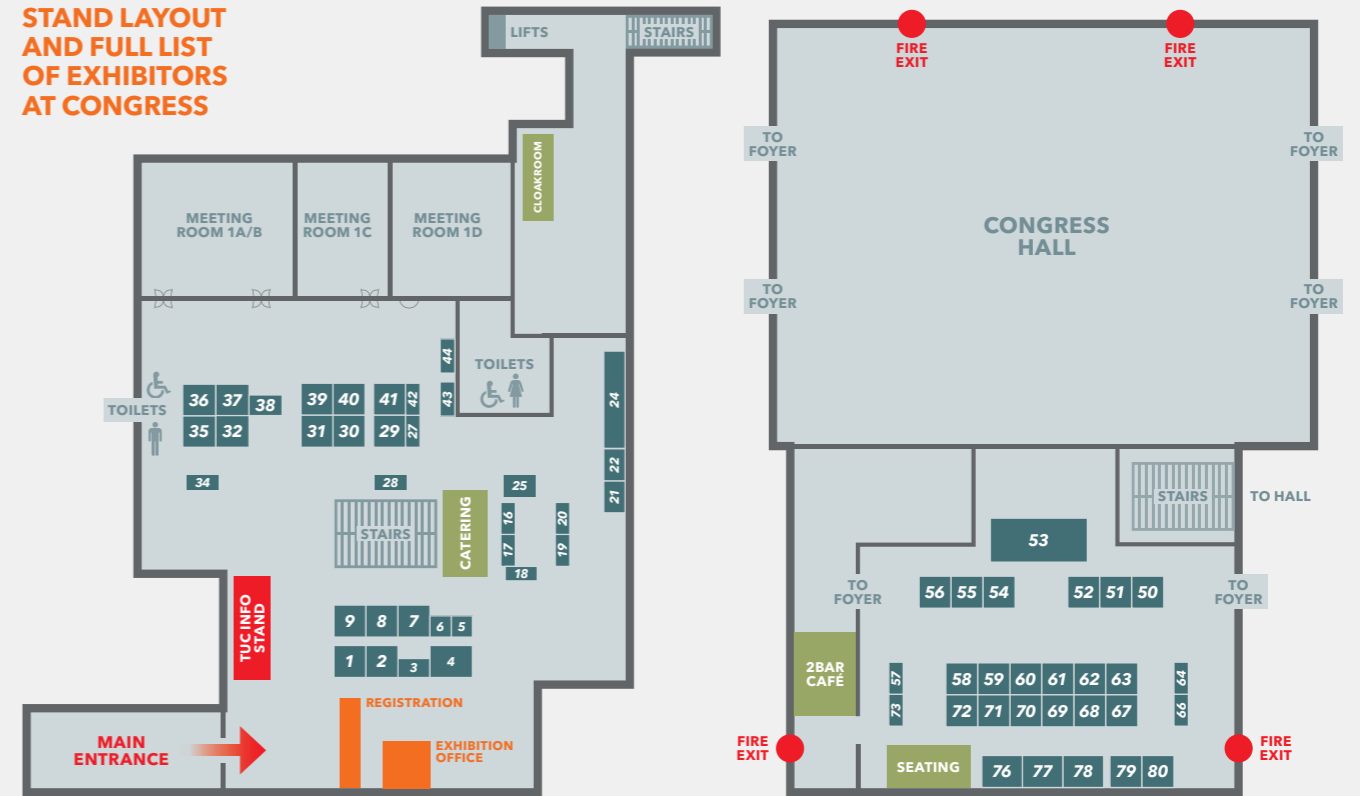
